ON CAMERA GUIDELINES DO'S & DON'TS





- Avoid wearing **extreme colors** such as white, black and bright red.
 - Avoid **hot colors** like hot pink, green, yellow, and orange.

• Avoid polka dots, stripes, plaid, or any type of **crazy pattern** – lines on screen will look like they're moving, and it can make viewers feel dizzy.

• Avoid wearing **logos and sayings**. It can send a wrong message and even cause trouble with copyright.

Pick deep-rich colors. Wear **blues**, **cobalt** and **purple**. **Pastels** work on camera too!



- Avoid **heavy fabrics**, they will make you hot and sweaty under the camera lights.
- For women, avoid **short skirts** (especially if you are sitting down)
- Avoid showing too much skin (naked shoulders, deep cleavage etc.)
- Avoid wearing clothes that are **too tight** or **too loose**.



Cotton or **light fabrics** are the way to go. And iron your clothes! Wrinkles stand out



- Avoid heavy and clanky jewelry. Dangly earrings are distracting.
 - Try to stay away from **anything that reflects** or glares.
 - Try not to use too many **hair products**, they might shine.
 - Avoid glossy lipsticks, reflective lips look weird on camera.

Use some **powder**, it will deflect the lights.
